
Dear Parents,

English

Our focus for the first two weeks in English will be on recounts. Particularly talking about what we have done over the holidays. We will learn the different time connectives that we can use to order a recount chronologically.



We will also be learning to re-tell and change the story Goldilocks and the Three Bears. Our 'toolkits' for writing are growing and we should now be including lots of punctuation in our writing. This includes: capital letters, full stops, commas, speech marks and exclamation marks. We will be using the same toolkit when looking at other traditional tales this month.

Topic


We have started off our topic with some fantastic rockets created at home! Thank you for your support. As you are aware this month our topic is 'To infinity and beyond'. We will be looking at important events and important people. The main person we will look at this month is Neil Armstrong. We will explore why it was important that he was the first person to walk on the moon.

Maths

At the start of this term we will be reinforcing place value. We will look at splitting numbers into the correct values.



We will use this knowledge when answering addition and subtraction questions. We will be beginning to look at column addition and subtraction.

Science

We are looking at living things this month. We will be exploring and comparing things that are dead or living and things that have never been alive. The children will identify habitats and the basic needs of animals and plants looking at how they depend on each other. The children will learn to identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats including micro-habitats.
