Curriculum Content for March

During March, your child will be studying the following topics:

KS3

Grade 6: Fruits & vegetables.

Use verb être (to be) Ask questions and develop a line of enquiry based on their knowledge and experience	Male & female adjectives. Comment tu te sens? Heureux/heureuse, fâché/fâchée, ennuyeux /ennuyeuse, excité/excitée, inquiet/inquiète, fatigué/fatiguée....

Your child will be given one oral assessment and one spelling vocabulary quiz and will be expected to write a few sentences for each topic.
