Dear Parents and Guardians,

You are cordially invited to attend a Progress Evening on:

**Monday 15<sup>th</sup> January between 4:40pm and 7:00pm or Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> January between 4.30pm and 7:00pm**

As a response to parental requests, all teachers from Pre-KG to Grade 10 will be available on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> January to trial a whole school Parent's Evening. Term 1 grade cards can be collected on the above dates and times only. Any grade cards which are not signed for on these evenings will be sent home on the 24<sup>th</sup> January.

All specialist English and Arabic medium teachers for Grades 6 to 10 will be available in the hall for 5 minute walk up appointments. Please see the back of this letter for further details of subject specialist teachers who teach across more than the Secondary grades.

The specialist teachers will review progress to date for all students and set new targets where appropriate. The evening will also identify, if necessary, any concerns regarding your child's attitude to learning and any barriers to learning such as homework, behaviour, punctuality or uniform.

We would kindly request that you keep to the 5 minute appointment slot so that everyone has an opportunity to see the teacher. We would also request that you wait patiently and respect the other parents by allowing the parent who has been waiting the longest to see the teacher first and so on.

Your child will have completed a list of their teachers' names. Please collect it on arrival on the night from the sign in desk.

Children below Grade 6 are asked not to attend on this evening in order to enable the parents and teachers to focus clearly on the conversation regarding the child. Any child from Grade 6 and above who is attending must do so with the purpose of being involved in the meetings. If children from Grade 5 or below must attend we ask that they use the crèche provided by the PTT or are closely supervised throughout by parents. School will not be responsible for the well being of unsupervised children on these evenings.
