This month, in preparation for their final exams the students are creating pitches for their own TV drama series. They are considering ideas for a pilot episode as well as an overarching narrative arc for the series. They are also considering ways this could be promoted both on-line and in print.

In the exam they will answer four questions in which they will relay the ideas they are working on in class. They will also be asked a theory question about why TV dramas are popular. In this answer they will need to reference at least two drama series that they have watched in full. Therefore, it is expected that the students complete research both at home and in class into the popularity of their chosen shows.

In late April the students will receive the final preliminary material for their exam. The work we are doing now is directly linked to this therefore the more research they complete now the better prepared they will be for their actual exam.
