Dear Parents and Guardians,

Grade 5 curriculum for March

English

In English we are going to look at poetry. We will use our inference skills to understand the meanings of different poems. We will look at the structures and rhyming patterns, analyse themes in poetry and also have a go at writing our own poems.

Maths

In Maths we will divide numbers up to 4 digits by a two-digit whole number using an efficient written method of long division, and interpret remainders as whole number remainders, fractions, or by rounding, as appropriate for the context. We will also divide numbers up to 4 digits by a two-digit number using an efficient written method of short division where appropriate, interpreting remainders according to the context

Finally, we will use estimation to check answers to calculations and determine, in the context of a problem, an appropriate degree of accuracy. Finally we will use written division methods in cases where the answer has up to two decimal places

Topic

This term we are going to explore South America. We are going to locate where South America is in relation to the rest of the world and the countries that make up South America. We will then move on

to looking at Rainforests and focus particularly on the Amazon rainforest and river.

Science

In Science we will be continuing with our topic, Light. We will complete our investigations about reflection and refraction as well as making our own periscopes and light prisms. Thank you for all of the fantastic Science projects we received.
