How Can You Support Your Child's Learning?

- Ensure you check that your child's books are clearly highlighted and labelled as some children are bringing their History book to Geography class and vice versa.
- Ensure your child has all necessary lesson equipment in class to avoid wasting time during lessons.
- Practice key words and long answer questions with your child for all topics covered in class. Challenge your child and give them a written quiz at home.
- Check your child's organiser and homework every evening in order to reinforce concepts covered in class.
- Revising and researching topics on the internet will aid their learning. Refer to useful websites e.g. BBC Bitesize.
- Watch YouTube videos related to relevant topics for further understanding.

Upcoming Events

- Core Competency Skills - Students are encouraged to demonstrate such skills throughout the month and in the thereafter. They are invited to research such topics at home and present ideas to their form tutors during form time each week.
